Learning Intentions - EYFS

EAD

- We will be creating using a variety of different media-painting, gluing.
- We will be joining in with singing and through weekly band sessions learning about rhythms and different sounds.
- The children will begin to construct and use a variety of materials to create sculptures and pictures.
- Children will be encouraged to draw with increasing detail using observation and imagination.



PSED

- We will continue to learn about nursery routines and expectations.
- We will be engaging in cooperative activities and learning to share spaces and resources. 'My turn, Your turn' terminology will be introduced.
- We will talk about and label emotions
- Visual timetables will be displayed to support children with the routine of the day and to help with understanding of the passing of time.

Literacy

- We will be sharing a variety of books and children will be encouraged to join in with familiar phrases and to learn new vocabulary.
- We will be introduced to sounds through The Foundations to Phonics Little Wandle programme.
- We will continue rhyme time and story through Little Wandle.
- Print in the environment will be reflective of themes and children's interests.
- Mark making opportunities available through writing cards for Christmas, shopping lists, children encouraged to write their names using name cards as prompts.

Physical

- The children will be offered a variety of activities to support gross motor movement.
- Continue Dough Disco and Finger Gym activities.
- Children will be encouraged to become independent at lunchtimes, using a knife and fork to feed themselves.
- The children will be encouraged to become independent with self help skills.



UW

- Become more confident when talking about people that are familiar to us and talking about ourselves.
- We will reflect on important events and learn about diversity.
- The children will be encouraged to develop curiosity about the world around them and talk about similarities and differences.
- Talk about the weather each day during autumn.
- Explore collections of natural materials with similar and different properties.



CL

- The children will be involved in activities that promote listening and attention in small group situations.
- Children will be encouraged to talk about familiar books.
- Children to use language to extend their play, describe their pictures and to express their own ideas.
- Symbols will be used to support understanding of routines and expectations.
- Introduce new vocabulary and Makaton related to themes.

Maths

- We will be using number spontaneously in play and counting to 10.
- Children will have access to a variety of activities that encourage them to count items 1:1.
- Children will begin to describe simple AB patterns, extending to ABC patterns, using colours and other materials.
- Children will begin to recognise when there is 1 or 2 objects in a set and begin to represent numbers 1 and 2. Introduce Ten Town.
