### Using Positional Language

#### Activity 1

Use the billy goats and ask your child to place them around your house, using the following positional language:

On

Under

Between

In

In front of

Behind

Next to

Over



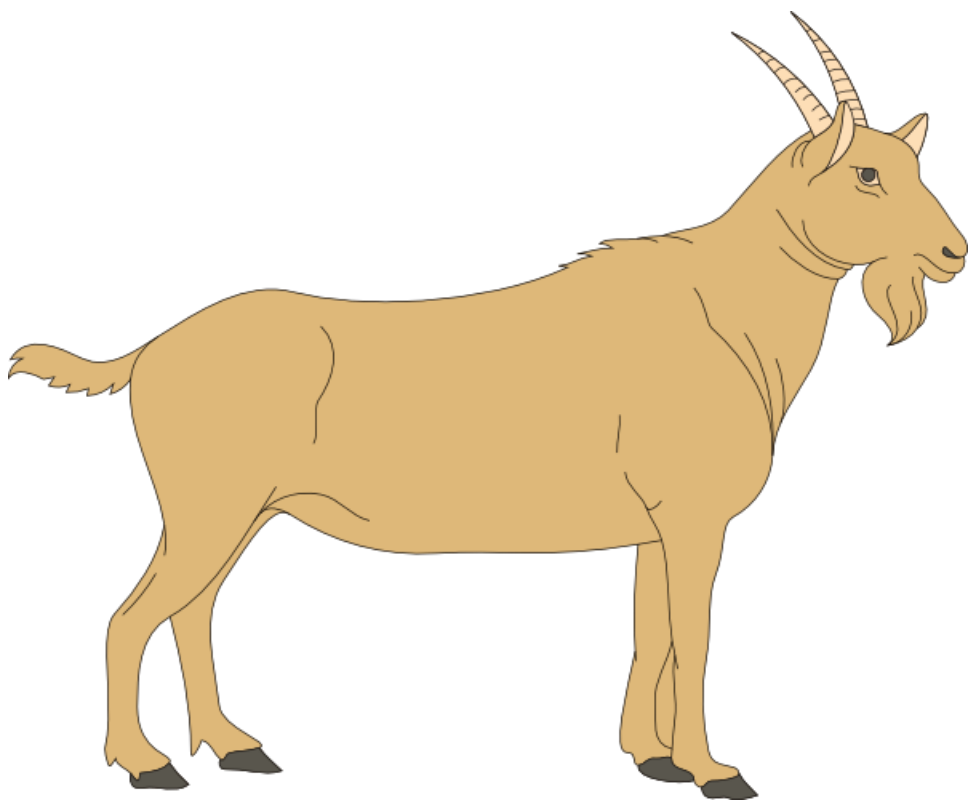
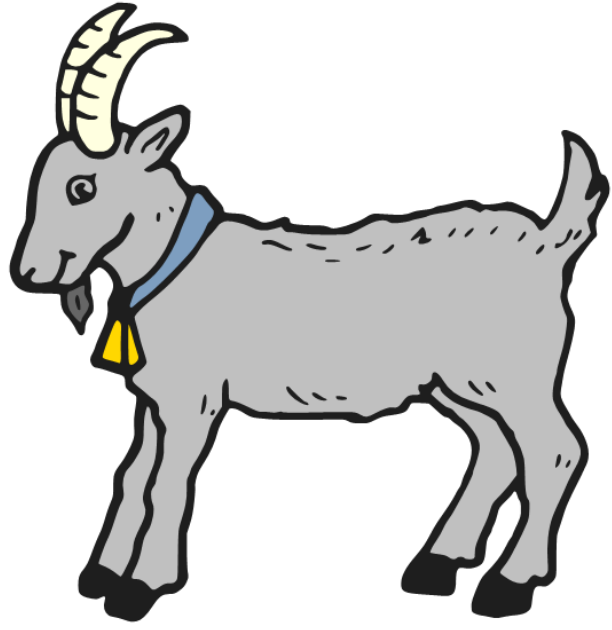
For example you could ask your child to, 'Put the Little Billy Goat under the sofa.'

'Put the Big Billy Goat between the books.'

'Put the Medium Billy Goat in the cupboard.'

To support your child you can ask them to select any billy goat. Don't add the size or simplify the question, 'Billy goat in cupboard.'

As your child places the billy goats in the places you asked, tick off the ones they can do on the tick chart.

## Activity 2

### Hide and Seek

Encourage your child to use positional language.

Using some small world resources, i.e. cars, people, trains - hide them around the house.

Once they are hidden ask your child to go and search for them. When they find them ask them to tell you where they found the object. Repeat back what they say to consolidate understanding of each concept.

I.e. Your child finds a car under the bin. When they find it ask them, 'where did you find it?' They will respond, 'Under the bin.' Repeat back, 'Yes the car was under the bin.' Give lots of praise!
