Expressive Arts and Design

This week you can make your own Elmer the elephant or you could make lots of elephants from the story.

What you will need to do:

1. Wash out a plastic milk bottle and let it dry. You could use different sizes.
2. Cut it off at the handle - see image below. This will give you your elephant shape.
3. Cut a 'U' shape from the sides to make the legs.
4. Now your bottle elephant is ready to decorate.
5. Encourage your child to complete the plan below before they make their elephant.
6. After they have finished ask your child to write a sentence about what they like about their elephant.
