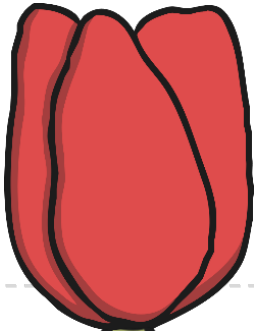


Complete the picture below by drawing each part of the plant. The roots have been done for you. Label and explain what each part of the plant is for.

Flowers attract insects to the flower to collect pollen.

A seed contains food so a new plant can grow from it.

Leaves make food from sunlight and the air.

The stem carries water around the plant.

Roots take nutrients and water from the soil.

Look at this aerial photograph of Riverside. Write the numbers in the table to match it to the correct location. Can you then draw your own aerial view of somewhere of your choice and label it?

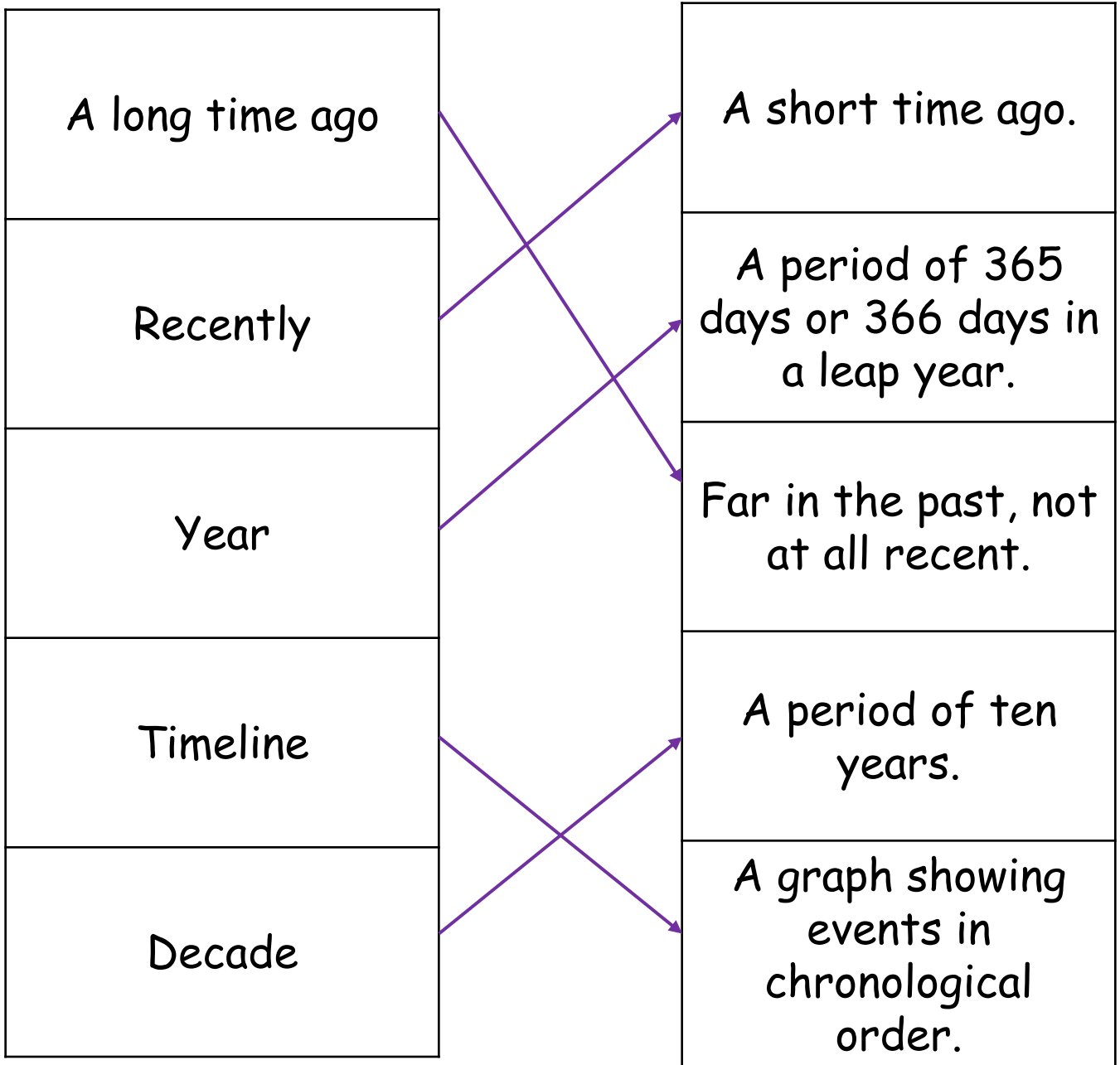
