 A **deciduous** tree loses its leaves each year. In autumn, the leaves change colour and fall off. In winter, a deciduous tree becomes bare.

An **evergreen** tree keeps its green leaves all year round. Evergreen leaves are: small, narrow, thick and waxy.



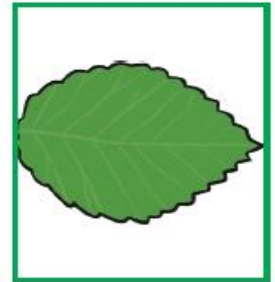
Two trees shown below are evergreen, the rest are deciduous.

- Did you find any leaves that are not shown below?

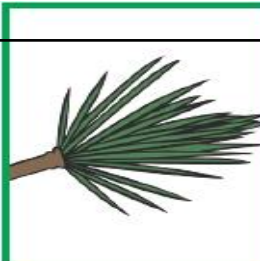
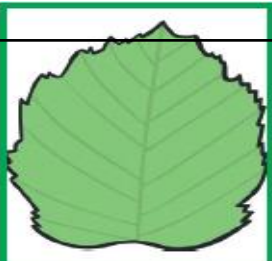

A human feature has been built by humans, such as bridges and roads.

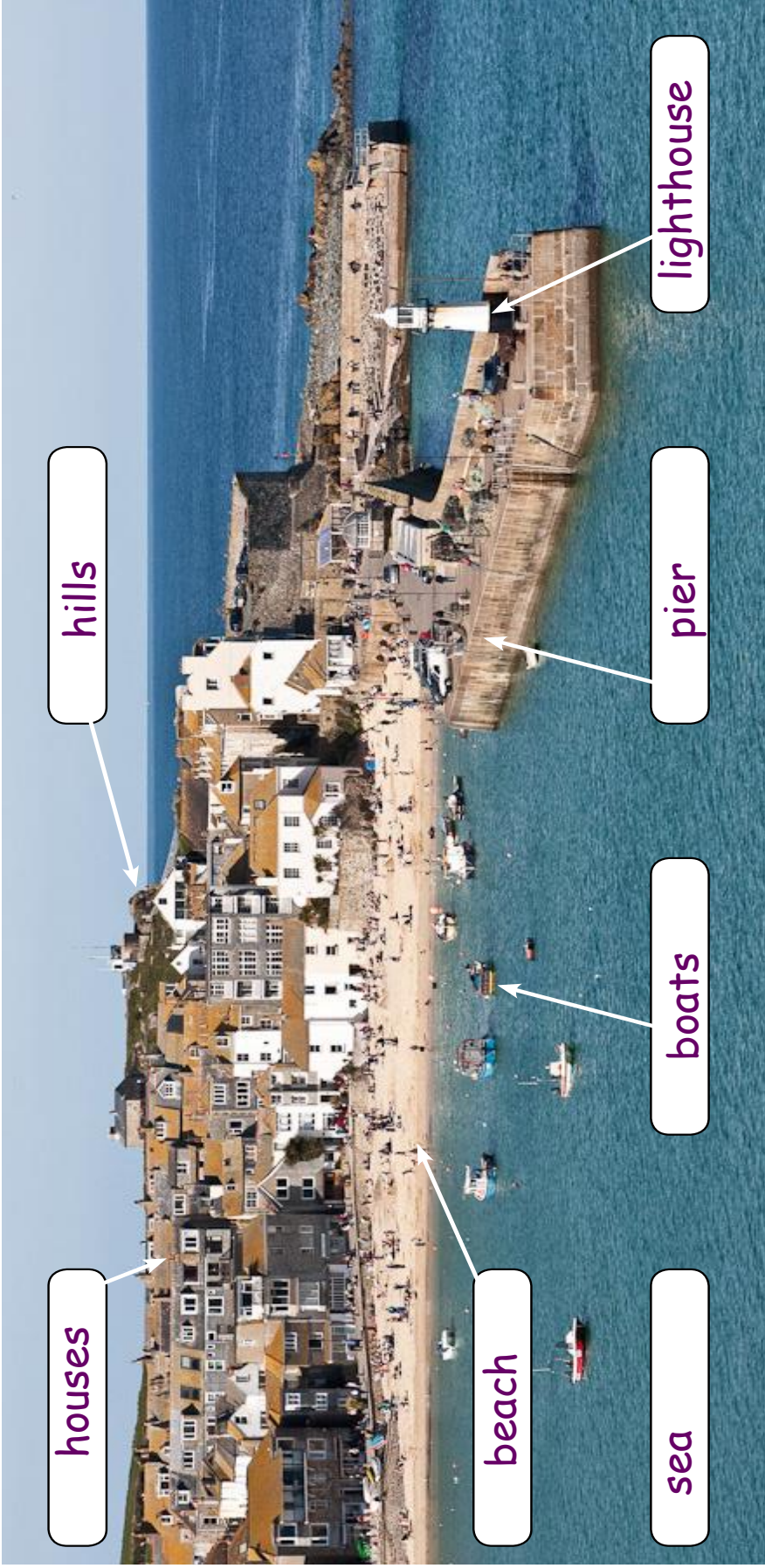
A physical feature is a natural feature, such as rivers or mountains.
