

Giraffes- the savanna



long eyelashes to help keep the sun and dust from their eyes

long, strong tongues enable them to strip the rough foliage

a thick coating of glue-like saliva protects the giraffe from injuries from thorns and sharp branches

long necks to allow them to reach the high levels of the treetops

camouflage- baby giraffes are at risk from predators so their colouring helps to blend in with their surroundings

Living things have a wonderful way of changing to suit their environments; this is called adaptation. Use the example above to find out about how other animals and plants have adapted to suit their surroundings.

Sir Francis Drake

In Plymouth, there is a shopping centre named after him as well as a statue at Plymouth Hoe. 19 British navy ships or bases have been named after him.

Historian Harry Kelsey claims Drake was a "**ruthless, arrogant, self-willed, covetous, money-minded, and amoral**" man. He goes on to label him a **bully and sociopath**.

Sir Francis Drake is one of the most well-known explorers of the Tudor era.

Find out about what he did and why some accounts of him present him as a hero, whilst others see him as a villain!

Did you use some kind of table to show what you found out? Hero on one side, villain on the other? Possibly a mind map, using different colours to show the positive and negative points?

Key things that could have been mentioned include:

Hero: Drake was the first Englishman to circumnavigate the globe- glory!

He brought enormous wealth back to England from Spanish ships.

Villain: The Spanish thought he was just a pirate! The king of Spain offered 20,000 ducats (around £4million today) for his life.

Drake traded in slaves- he made a fortune capturing and transporting African people.





Rearrange the anagrams to match the geographical definition.
